WE RECENTLY HAD THE PRIVILEGE OF A CANDID INTERACTION WITH OUR ESTEEMED GUEST MUNICIPAL COMMISSIONER,

DR. VIPIN SHARMA - IAS,

AND HE WAS EXTREMELY KIND TO SHARE A FEW OF HIS THOUGHTS WITH OUR LEADERSHIP TEAM

1. What are the recent accomplishments of TMC that you would want more people to know about?

There are many accomplishments, however, I would like to give priority to 2 specific initiatives which highlights the resilience and stakeholder participation demonstrated by the city of Thane during the pandemic. We have built our first jumbo Covid hospital from scratch in just 24 days with the help of various stakeholders, and later added 2 more jumbo hospitals & other Covid healthcare facilities. The way stakeholders came forward, from all walks of life, to help the TMC in its endeavor to provide health amenities, infrastructure and healthcare needs is a strong indication of how much citizens care and that stakeholders are an important part of team Thane, apart from the the administration.

Further, we are the only municipal corporation that has its own medical college, own hospitals, even its own chowpatty, which we are aiming to connect with waterways.

2. What is your take on UDCPR-34? Any specific rules you would like to highlight?

Real estate is the 2nd largest employer after agriculture in our economy. And so, if the sector is so important, anything to do with this sector has to be equally path-breaking.

The new UDCPR-2034 is a very progressive document and aims to tackle the complications of developing urban infrastructure with restricted land banks in terms of housing, office spaces and civic amenities. It is a smooth flowing, streamlined, coherent document, and has simplified the entire development control regulations. Further, it opens up new vistas for development in terms of FSI available, process of approval, p-line area calculation concept and guidelines what can and cannot be done.

3. What are your plans on its implementation?

Solid implementation strategy forms the foundational block towards the success of any new policy. With that mindset, we have ushered in a holistic approach in the implementation of new UDCPR revolving around training, software implementation and guery resolution. We have conducted focused training sessions for town planning officials, staff members, architects and developers. Further, we are technically contributing towards a software being developed at the State level, which will incorporate all the elements of new DCR to ensure seamless process flow, and make it paperless. This is critical to the scale and speed of adoption. Last but not the least, we are interacting and coordinating continuously with developers, architects and appropriate levels in the government to have an all-encompassing involvement of all stakeholders in the UDCPR implementation

4. Are there any upcoming developments in infrastructure, healthcare, transportation?

In infrastructure, we have two railway overbridges coming soon – one in Kopri, which has been dedicated to public last week itself, and and the other in Kalwa, where work is 70% complete and we plan to start one side of this by December 2021.

On the healthcare front, we have succeeded in bringing Tata Cancer Hospital to Thane, the formal agreement is already under the process. We are now also working to develop a super-specialty hospital in Thane.

In transportation, the Thane internal metro plan has been resubmitted to the Government. Very soon we will have the approval to start work on our own city metro, which will seamlessly connect internal areas of Thane with the state Metro lines 4 and 5. Further, we have already prepared a DPR of coastal

road that is to be executed by MMRDA. It is a 1200 crore plus project, so process of seeking appropriate approvals is going on and we are hopeful that soon it will reach the tender stage.

5. What message do you have for everyone that is considering making our beautiful city of Thane their home?

Thane is known as the city of lakes. Further, we have been ranked as the most environmentally friendly city in Maharashtra - ranked first in Majhi Vasundhara Abhiyaan 2021, which is based on 5 elements - earth, water, air, fire and sky. Hence, I believe Thane has the perfect combination of nature, upcoming urban infrastructure, modern development and cosmopolitan neighborhood to make it one of the most liveable world class cities!

6. Anything you would like to share about yourself, your interests, your hobbies?

The assignment of Thane Municipal Commissioner is as challenging and engaging as it is fulfilling for me. So, the time is always at a premium. However, I really like reading, not a particular type, but anything as long as it meets the quality. I am particularly interested in sectors like urban planning, urban infrastructure and urban finance. I like travelling and I am very strong believer of democratic values and public service ethos, which I strive to achieve in my day to day functioning as the Municipal Commissioner. Thane is in a critical phase of development and this is the window, wherein we have the potential to get catapulted from just a bustling neighborhood of Mumbai to a world class city. We must not miss this opportunity!







The first school founded in Bandra was St Andrew's Parish School, started by Fr. Francisco de Melo in 1780 to teach catechism to the children of the parish. This later became St. Andrew's High School.


